Bachelor of General Science Degree from Palmer College of Chiropractic

The Bachelor of Science degree curriculum includes courses in natural/physical sciences, business, communications, psychology, and social sciences/humanities. It complements the Doctor of Chiropractic Program curriculum; and courses are offered at times that accommodate students who obtain both degrees simultaneously.

The minimum program requirements are 121 total semester (credit) hours:

- Sixty (60) 100-200 level credit hours (earned through Westmoreland County Community College Associate Degree)
- Thirty (30) 300-400 level credits (earned through Palmer's BS program)
- Thirty-one (31) natural/physical sciences earned in the DC program at Palmer.
